## Ontario Student Assistance Program

May to August 2017

**FULL-TIME GRADUATE** students that have previously applied for OSAP for Fall/Winter 2016-2017 must complete a Western supplemental OSAP application. **Application Deadline is July 15, 2017. Supporting Documentation Deadline is 40 days prior to your study period end date.**

Students that are applying for the first time (May-August term) must also apply online at:

<https://ontario.ca/page/osap-ontario-student-assistance-program>. **Application Deadline is 60 days prior to your study period end date. Supporting Documentation Deadline is 40 days prior to your study period end date.**

**PART-TIME GRADUATE** students must complete the “OSAP Application for Part-Time Students” web application which can be found online at <https://ontario.ca/page/osap-ontario-student-assistance-program>. **Application and Supporting Documentation Deadline is 42 days prior to your study period end date.**

Once your application is submitted please hand in your completed signature pages and other required documentation (if any) to Western Student Services Building: Student Financial Aid, Room 1100. You can also visit Student Central, Room 1120, Western Student Services Building for additional information.

**PART-TIME GRADUATE** students **with permanent disability** have the option to apply for Full-Time or Part-Time OSAP.

You are required to notify Student Financial Aid IN WRITING or by APPOINTMENT of all changes in your financial information, status, course load, etc. Any change may result in a reassessment of your OSAP entitlement.
