Students entering a graduate program in the Winter and Summer terms will be billed in January and May, respectively, with adjusted fees.

Note 2: The SOGS Health & Dental Plan Administration Fee is collected annually and typically in September. Students entering a graduate program in January or May will be charged an adjusted amount.
