

## In Absentia Convocation

The University of Western Ontario, established in 1878, is an accredited degree granting institution incorporated under law by the Ontario legislature. The University is also a member of The Association of Universities and Colleges of Canada, The International Association of Universities and the Association of Commonwealth Universities.

Senate approved the establishment of an in absentia convocation to be held in mid-February for students who complete their degree requirements by the end of the preceding fall session.

In Absentia degrees were conferred on February 24, 2023. There is no ceremony for this convocation in February. Students who have their degrees conferred in February will be given the opportunity to participate in the appropriate June 2023 convocation ceremony.

Students will not receive formal documentation about the June 2023 convocation. They will be able to register for their convocation date in early June and order tickets at the same time.
