

## Is my tuition deferred to OSAP?

How to tell if your tuition has been deferred until your OSAP arrives.

**What is this?** The Net Cost View tells you how much of your tuition installment is not paid by OSAP or Western funding. The Amount Due is the amount you must pay by your installment due date\*.

- If **OSAP Funding to Come equals \$0**, Western has received all of the OSAP going toward your current installment. You are responsible for any outstanding **Amount Due**.
- If your OSAP payment is greater than the amount owing to Western, any leftover OSAP funding will be sent directly to your bank account.
- OSAP information relating to the installment amount shown is based on current information. If there is a change to registration or OSAP entitlement, these amounts may change.

If you are an Out of Province student, you need to send a copy of your Notice of Assessment to [contact@uwo.ca](mailto:contact@uwo.ca) before December 1st to ensure your fees are deferred. If your second installment of funding is not enough to cover your outstanding fees you must pay the difference by the due date.
