Jacob Family International Study Award is awarded to an undergraduate student in any year of any program wishing to study abroad or on exchange for a minimum of one semester, based on the greatest demonstrated financial need and academic achievement (minimum 80% average). Preference will be given first to a student participating in an exchange to a partner university in Israel, then to a student studying at an accredited university in Israel. Preference will also be given to a student attending a full-year course over a one-semester course.

Award recipients will be announced in May of each year, but receipt of the award is dependent on an approved Letter of Permission and acceptance into an accredited university for study abroad.
